To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to follow up on your inquiry regarding PFOA content of our FEP insulated products.

The FEP manufacturing process utilizes perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) as a polymerization aid. The final virgin resin product is dried and melt-processed into pellets through an extrusion process. Based on the temperature of the drying process, the melting temperature of FEP, and the PFOA thermal degradation data it is estimated that no detectable amount of PFOA is present in the resin. However, in the case that any traces of PFOA remain in the resin, information provided by our supplier indicates that any PFOA would likely be destroyed in our extrusion process and should not be present in the finished product.
